Composting our waste food scraps, grass clippings, banana stems and manure (Nitrogen) with dry leaves and hay (Carbon) creates a healthy composted soil that is great for growing nutritious vegetables and fruit for us to eat. Mr Gemmell is an excellent Permaculture teacher and he was happy to share his knowledge with our classes.

In three weeks our compost will be ready to use on our gardens. We love eating things we have cooked using ingredients from our school gardens.
